PAST CONTINUOUS

Kiedy używamy czasu Past Continuous?

- Czas Past Continuous używamy, aby opisać:
  - Czynności trwające w określonym momencie w przeszłości:
    - "At 8 p.m. yesterday, Tom Cruise was rehearsing for his new movie."
  - Długotrwałe czynności przerywane przez krótkie wydarzenia:
    - "While Leonardo DiCaprio was giving an interview, fans started cheering."
  - Równocześnie trwające czynności w przeszłości:
    - "Jennifer Lawrence was reading the script while her manager was talking on the phone."
  - Tło wydarzeń w opowiadaniach lub opisach sytuacji:
    - "The audience was waiting when the show finally began."

## Budowa zdania twierdzącego w czasie Past Continuous

- Konstrukcja:
- Podmiot (I, You, He, She, It, We, They) + was/were + czasownik z końcówką -ing
- Przykłady:
  - Taylor Swift was recording a new song when she received the award news.
  - Chris Hemsworth was preparing for his role as Thor last summer.
  - Scarlett Johansson was traveling when the movie premiered.
  - Tom Holland was studying his lines all day yesterday.

## Tworzenie zdań pytających w czasie Past Continuous

- Konstrukcja:
- Was/Were + podmiot + czasownik z końcówką -ing?
- Przykłady:
  - Was Emma Watson filming in London last month?
  - Were Robert Pattinson and Kristen Stewart rehearsing together for a new movie?
  - Was Ryan Reynolds training for his role during the winter?
  - Were Angelina Jolie and Brad Pitt discussing a new collaboration?

## Tworzenie zdań przeczących w czasie Past Continuous

- Konstrukcja:
- Podmiot + was not (wasn't) / were not (weren't) + czasownik z końcówką -ing
- Przykłady:
  - Leonardo DiCaprio wasn't filming in the city last week.
  - Lady Gaga wasn't performing at the concert because she was sick.
  - The Rock wasn't promoting his new movie last weekend.
  - Emma Stone wasn't planning any new projects at that time.

## Słówka i wyrażenia pomocne do czasu Past Continuous

Typowe słówka czasowe:

- **While (podczas gdy):** "While Jennifer Aniston was talking to the director, the producer called."
- **At that moment (w tamtym momencie):** "At that moment, Chris Evans was preparing for his next scene."
- **When (kiedy):** "When Tom Hiddleston was giving his speech, fans started clapping."
- **All day/night (cały dzień/noc):** "Brad Pitt was shooting scenes all night."
